Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for Lincoln Road Phase 2 in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Lamar County Board of Supervisors, located at 402 Pecan St, Purvis MS 39475. The funding would be used to update and improve 1.1 miles of Lincoln Road that extends from the Oak Grove Road intersection to Lamar Blvd.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide safety for the increased traffic flow and complete a 30-year project, connecting Highway 98 with Highway 49, making a major corridor for the area.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 23 U.S.C. 133(b).
